Figure 1. Number of HIV tests (ELISA) and number of persons with newly diagnosed HIV infection, 1993-2003




Figure 2. Incidence (per 10^5) of notified Danish-born persons with newly diagnosed HIV infection, by sex, 1991-2003




Figure 3. The proportion (percentage) of HIV-positive Danes and immigrants stating to having had sex with a person from a high-endemic area, by sex, 1990-2003



Figure 1. AIDS patients diagnosed in 2003, by county



ANNUAL REPORT ON HIV AND AIDS

This report includes all HIV and AIDS cases diagnosed up to 31 December 2003, notified to the Department of Epidemiology by 6 September 2004. The figures represent a minimum, as from previous experience occasional late notifications may arrive following the report date. This also explains the small adjustments that are continuously being made. AIDS was made a mandatorily notifiable disease in 1983. AIDS cases diagnosed before 1983 were subsequently included, so that the AIDS registration now includes all notified cases.

The notification system for HIV-positive persons came into force on 1 August 1990 and was last revised on 1 February 1992. Persons with newly diagnosed HIV infection are those who have previously not been found to be HIV-positive. This information is derived from the physicians' report form 4001-4.

<u>Figure 1</u> in the HIV report includes the total number of HIV-positive tests reported from laboratories performing confirmatory HIV tests.
