The travel

Depending on the nature of the travel, the suggestions are divided into four categories, roughly corresponding to the following: 1. Business or conference travel of some days' duration, to capital or other big city. Grp 1 may be supplemented from Grp 2, e.q. with A.

2. Tourist journey of up to four weeks' duration, including day excursions. If the travel is of a special nature, e.g. with intense exposure to risk of infection, Grp 2 may be supplemented from **Grp 3**, e.g. with J on insect exposure (trekking expedition), T in the event of extremely poor hygiene (trip to disaster area), M and/or D in case of close, local personal contact.

3. Individual travel of some months' duration, e.g. rucksack expedition and immigrants visiting family.

4. Prolonged individual journey for six months or more, persons stationed abroad or similar, frequently repeated visits.

NB: The programme will often have to be adapted to individual needs. On travel to border areas, vaccination recommendations for neighbouring countries may be included. Recommendations must be weighed against possible contraindications.

Typography of the symbols

Malaria prophylaxis is emphasised in **<u>bold type</u>** and is placed last in each column. <u>CAPITAL</u> LETTERS are used when the recommendation applies to all travellers, small letters when the application is limited. Thus, f, r, s refer to vaccination of selected travellers, and v, q, u, x, z refer to risk of malaria in a minor part of the country. <u>Seasonal variati-</u> ons are stated in numbers. When the risk is seasonal, usually the rainy season, the first and last month of the relevant period are stated at the top and bottom after the letter, respectively, e.g. Afghanistan U_{11}^{5} .

As the rainy season may vary from year to year, the numbers are only a quide.

Key to symbols

- A: Hepatitis A (from 1 year). Recommended to all immigrant children born in DK, EPI-NEWS 35/02. Immunoglobulin may be given to pregnant women.
- **B:** Hepatitis B (from birth).
- D: Diphtheria. All travellers should be vaccinated against both diphtheria and tetanus within the last 10 years. The vaccine is usually given as "Td vaccine for revaccination".
- f: Tick borne encephalitis (SSME/TBE) for regular activities in grassy deciduous woodlands during the summer half.
- G: Yellow fever (from 9 months). J: Japanese encephalitis (from 1 year), EPI-NEWS 03/97 and 50/99.
- M: Meningococcal disease A+C (from 2 years).
- **M**^{*} Meningococcal disease A+C+W135+Y (from 2 years). Mandatory on pilgrimage to Mecca, EPI-NEWS 23b/05. Recommended for a number of West African countries.
- **r:** Rabies, particularly in children and on travelling in remote territory.
- s: Tuberculosis. BCG for unvaccinated children (from birth) and young people on regular contact with members of the local population living in poor circumstances.
- T: Typhoid fever (injection from about 2 years, at specific risk from 18 months. Capsules from about 5 years).

Malaria prophylaxis:

- V: Very little risk, mosquito bite prophylaxis sufficient.
- Q: Chloroquine, alternatively V or X, depending on infection risk.
- U: Chloroquine + proguanil, alternatively mefloquine or Malarone.
- X: Mefloquine, Malarone or doxycycline.
- Z: Doxycycline or Malarone.

Basic vaccination of children and persons who have not received the common childhood vaccinations: EPI-NEWS 50/01.

Vaccination of children before stay in developing countries: EPI-NEWS 08/00.
